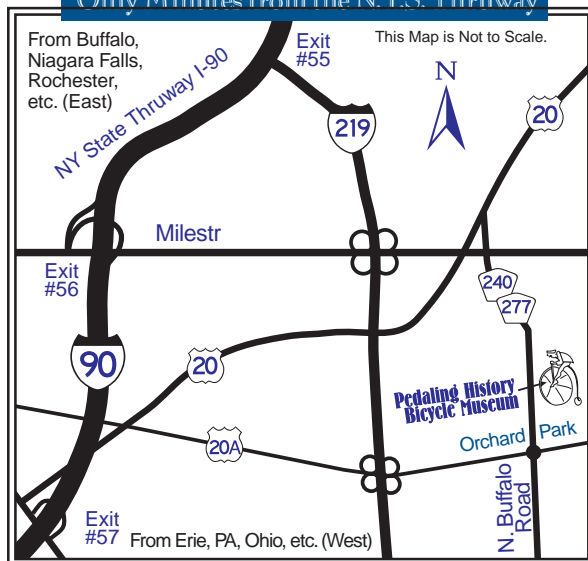


Easy To Get To... Easy To Enjoy!

Directions

Interstate I-90 Travel FROM NORTH / EAST

- Exit the New York State Thruway (I-90) at **Exit #56**.
- From toll-booth Access road turn **LEFT** (East) onto **Milestrip Road** (Route #179).
- You will travel 3.5 miles to the 8th traffic light – crossing McKinley Parkway, Abbott Road and Route #20 intersections.
- Turn **RIGHT** onto **N. Buffalo Road (Route #240 / #277)**. Proceed South for .6 mile, through one more light. **Pedaling History** is .3 mile past that light on your **LEFT**.

Interstate I-90 Travel FROM SOUTH / WEST

- Exit the New York State Thruway (I-90) at **Exit #57**.
- Leaving the Exit #57 toll booth, take the **first ramp** right onto **Route #75 North**, proceed to the first traffic light – **Route #20**.
- Turn **RIGHT** (East) on **Route #20** to 4th traffic signal and turn **RIGHT** onto **Route #20A** (Big Tree Road).
- Take **Route #20A** for 3 miles to the 4th traffic signal and turn **LEFT** onto **N. Buffalo Road (Route #240 / #277)**. **Pedaling History** will be on your **Right** in .8 mile.

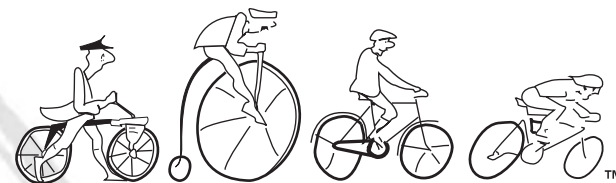
